Subject: *final exams to stay online*

Dear Graduating Students,

You have probably seen our rector's and chancellor's joint circular concerning exams in general and final exams in particular. This letter indicated that faculties and institutes are allowed to organize offline exams.

Because of the fact that we have already started to prepare for online final exams and this is exactly what we communicated to all of you at the end of April, and also because of the fact that travelling to Veszprém may be completely impossible to those who are currently outside the borders of the country – not to mention the unnecessary health risks this may involve – we have decided to stick to the original idea and keep our final exams online.

In our earlier circular, you have already been informed about the timing and administration of both the written and spoken parts of our final exams as well as the possible platforms. This letter is to confirm that we are keeping to the framework that we laid out in that circular.

We would like to draw your attention to one new feature, though: before the final exam, probably some time next week between May 25th and 29th we are planning to do a test run of the platforms we are going to use for the online final exams. We are going to let you know about the details of this later this week, so, please make sure that you follow the instructions in that later email and login in to the platforms in the time slots specified.

Also, you may expect the circular specifying your exact time slots for the oral components of the finals together with the names of the board members.

We hope that you are all in good health and manage to cope with the challenges of the lockdown – we are doing our best to make the taking of the final exam as problem free as possible.
